Vlad Tarabara is an Associate Professor of Environmental Engineering at Michigan State University. He received his Ph.D. from Rice University in 2004 and the same year joined faculty at MSU. Research in Dr. Tarabara's group is in the broadly defined area of water quality engineering with particular emphases on membrane separation processes, materials science of membranes, and nanotechnology-enabled water treatment solutions. He is a recipient of several awards including Paul L. Busch Award from Water Environment Research Foundation (2011), John K. Hudzik Emerging Leader in Advancing International Studies and Programs award from MSU (2010) and Graduate research award in membrane-based separations from the American Institute of Chemical Engineers (2003). He currently serves as an associate editor of the ASCE Journal of Environmental Engineering.
