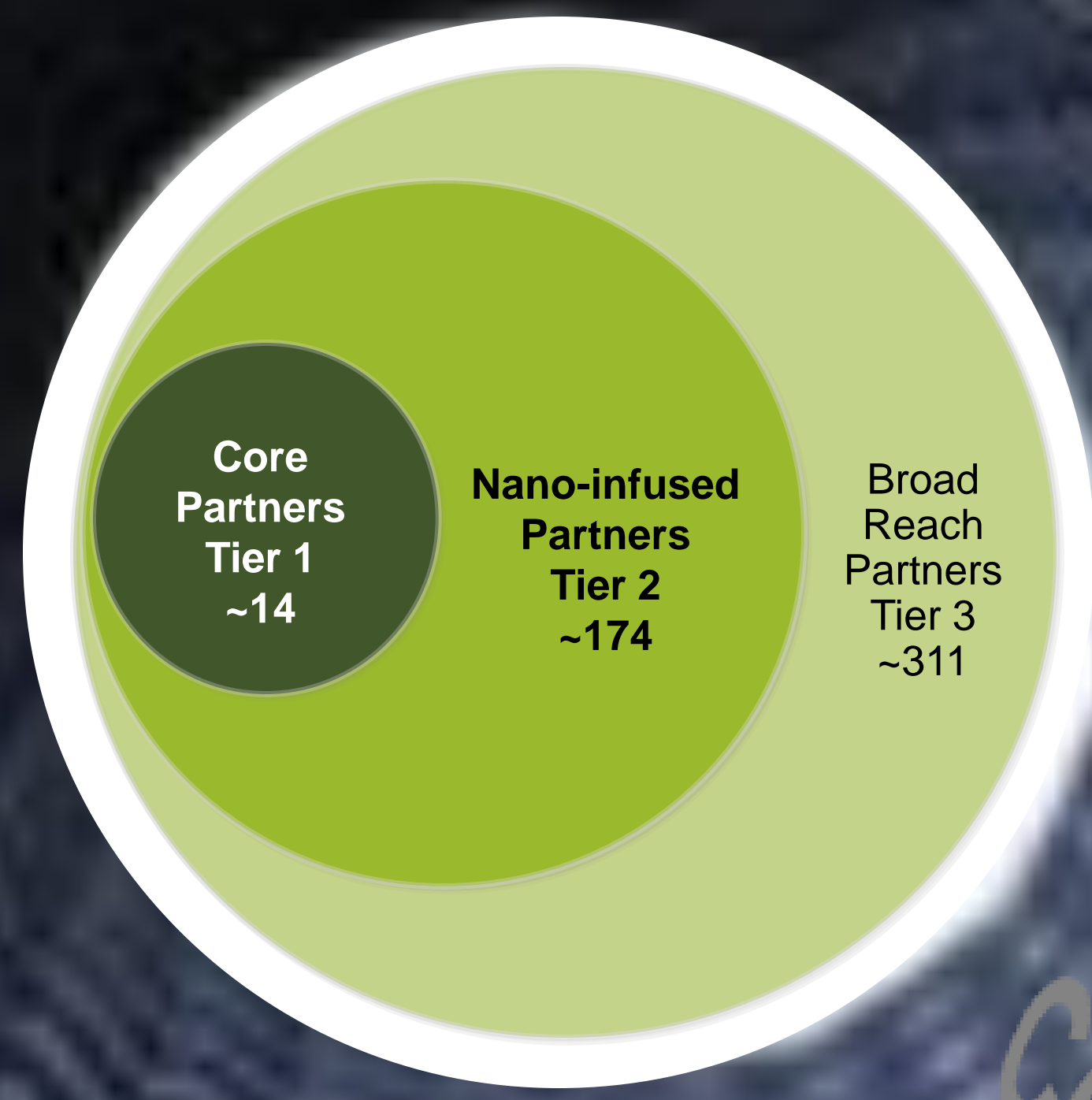

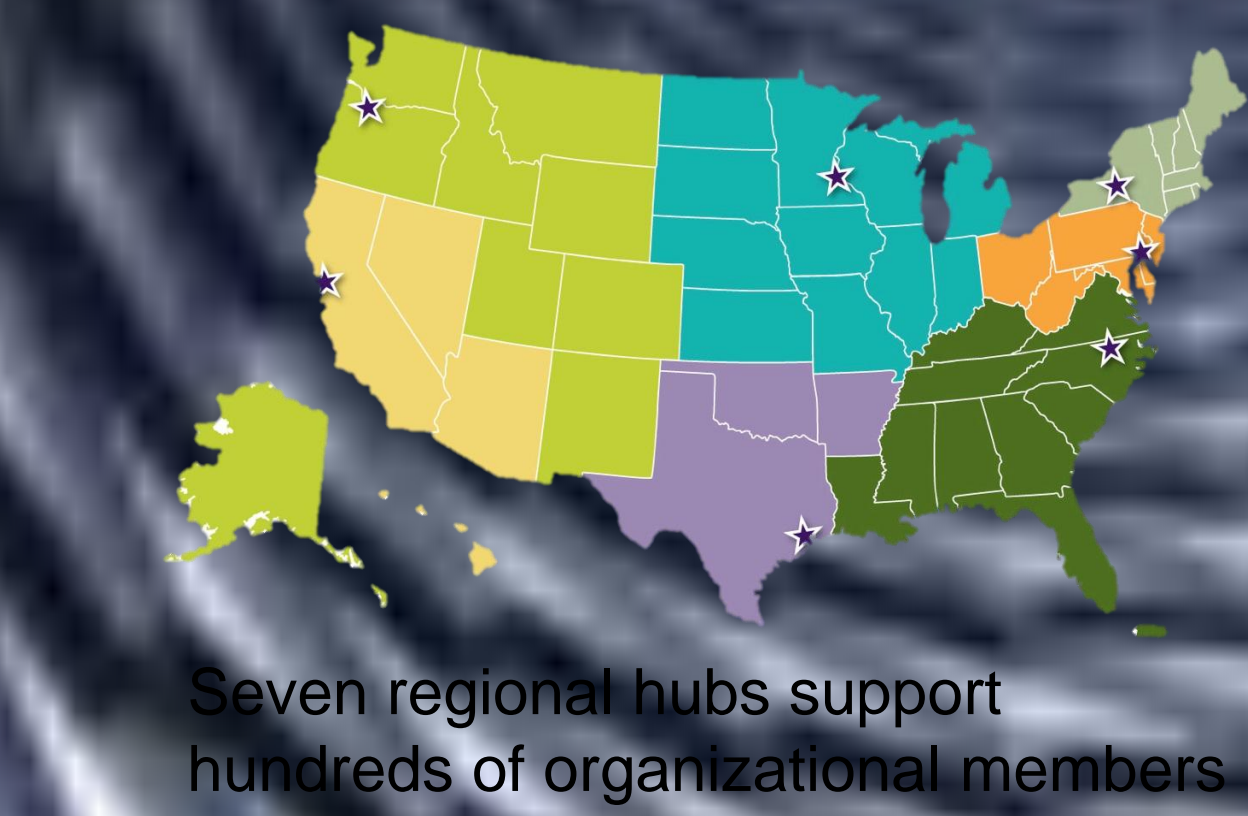

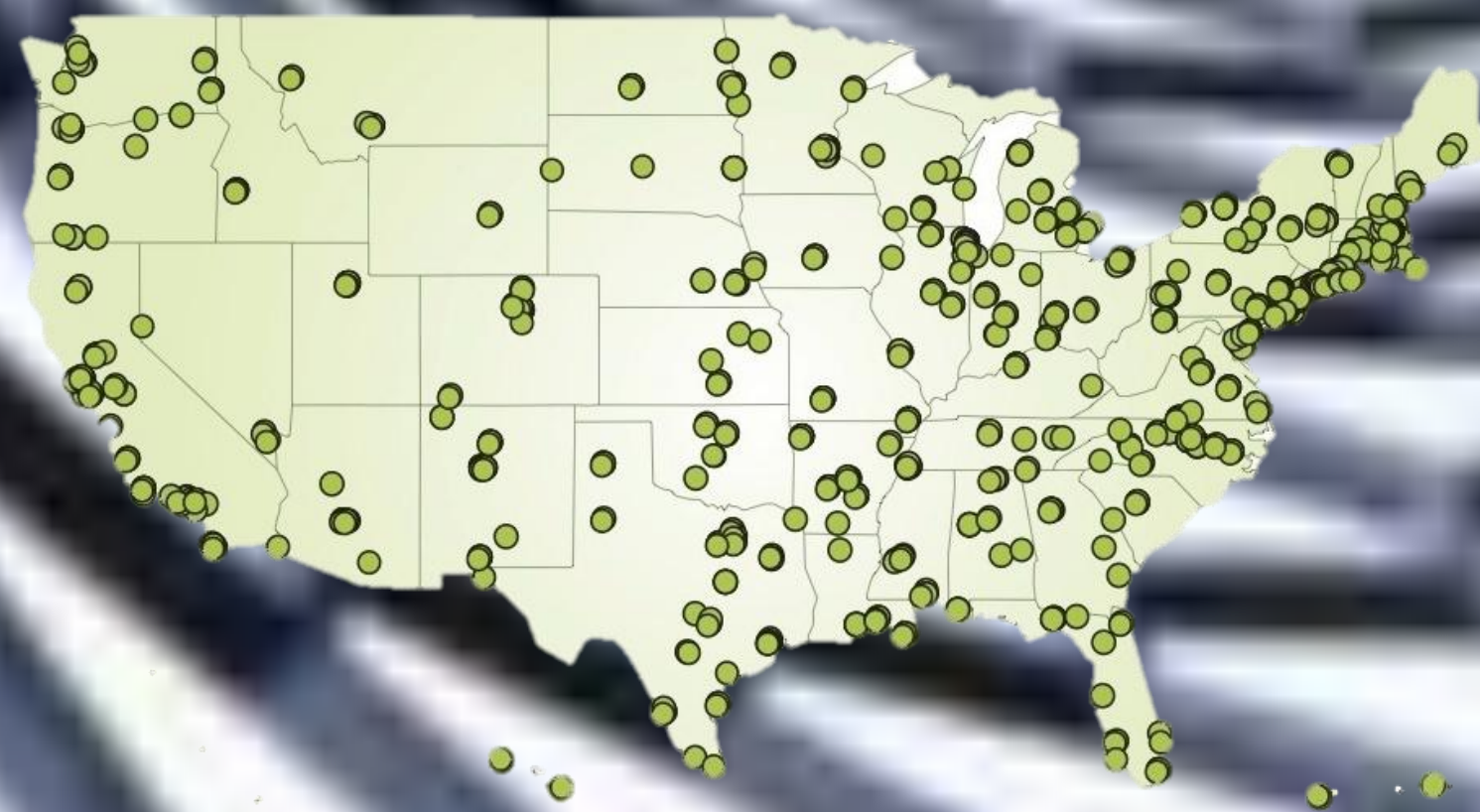

225 institutions get NanoDays kits annually and with their partners and others who download the online kit host events in every state



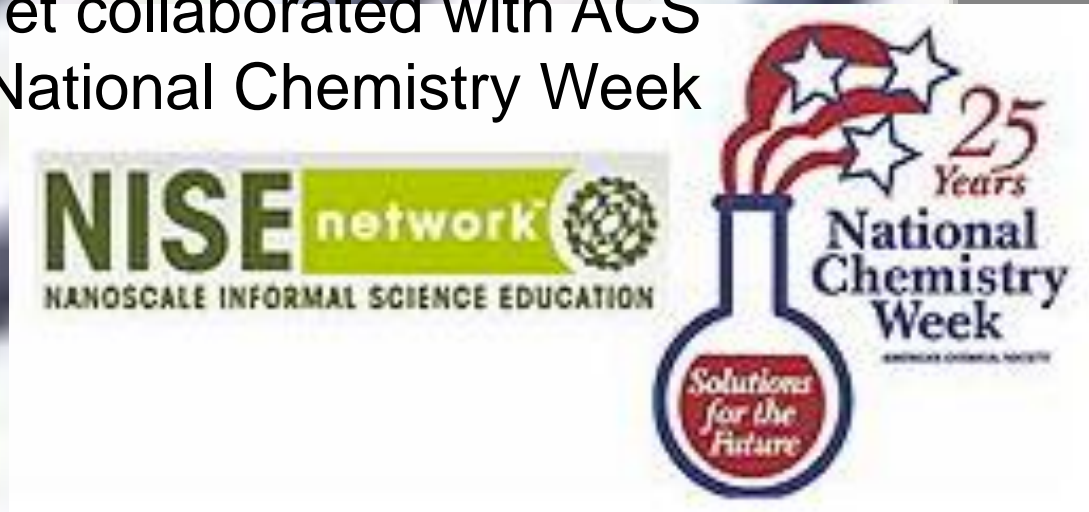

Mini-exhibition replicated for 70 sites over years 7-10

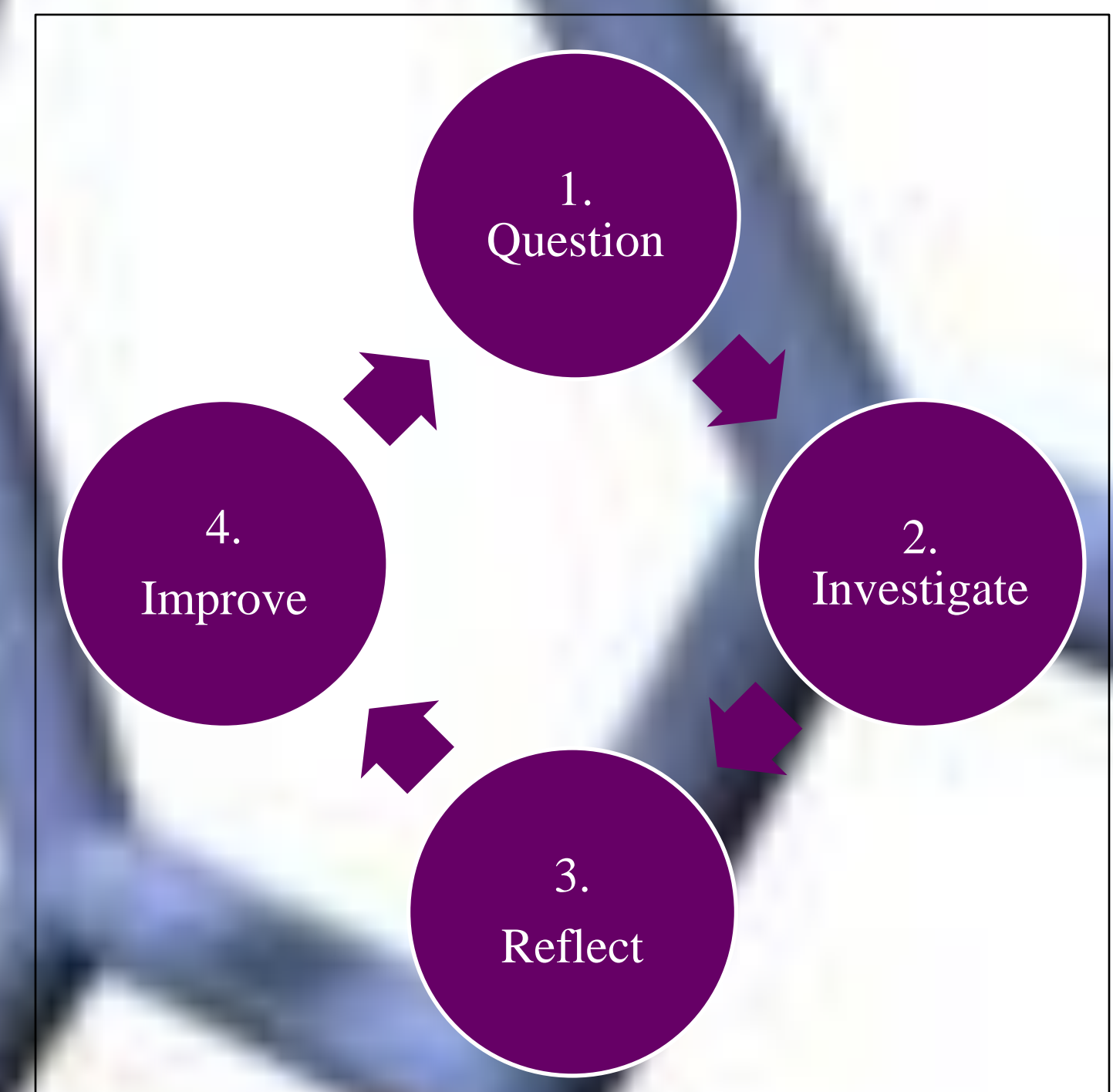

Nano & Society Workshops developed by CNS at ASU and NISE Net introduced new content and techniques

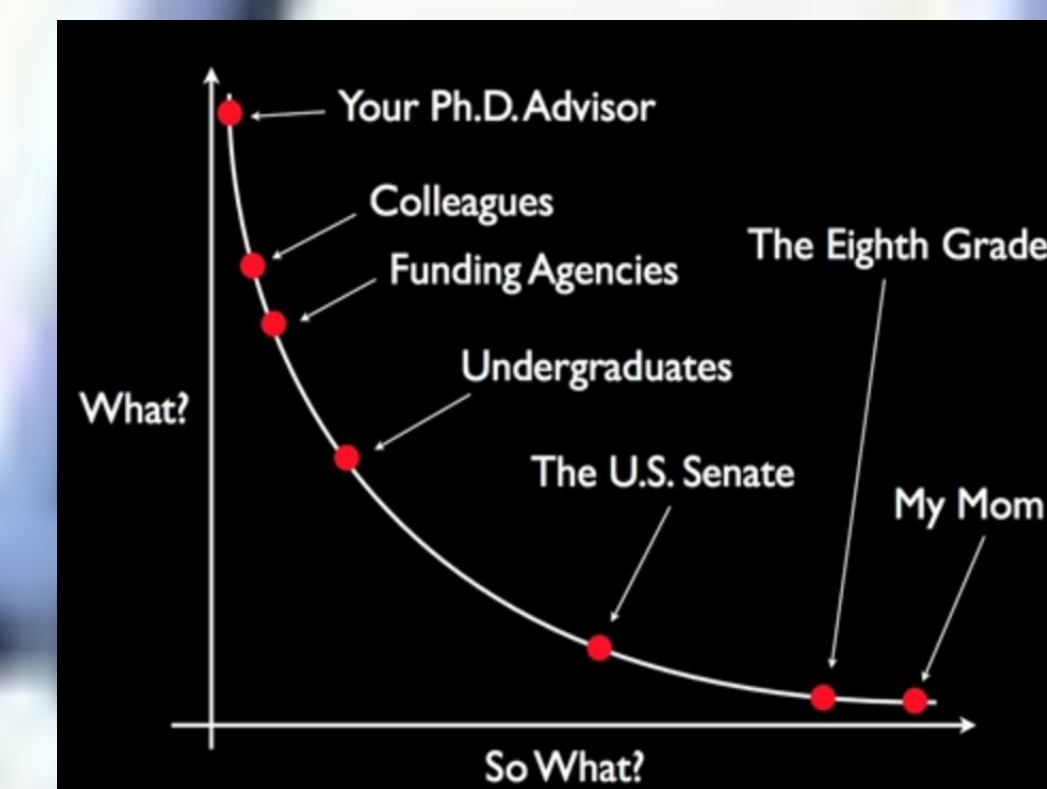
