

Nancy Healy has served as the Education and Outreach Director for the National Nanotechnology Infrastructure Network (NNIN). She assumed this Senior Academic Professional position at Georgia Institute of Technology in 2004 and has grown the NNIN E&O programs to an integrated partnership (14 universities) which reaches over 60,000 individuals each year. Prior to joining the NNIN, she was a program manager in the Academic Affairs Division at the S.C. Commission on Higher Education focused on science and math K-12 issues, teacher education, and teacher professional development. For ten years she served on the Board of Examiners for the National Council for the Accreditation of Teacher Education (now CAEP). She was also research faculty at the University of South Carolina where she taught undergraduates, had an active research program in paleo-oceanography, and numerous graduate students. She has published over 50 papers, 160 abstracts, and eight contract reports. She has a B.S. in Zoology from the University of Rhode Island and an M.S. and Ph.D. in Geological Sciences from the University of South Carolina.
