Dr. Charles Geraci is the Associate Director for Emerging Technologies for NIOSH. He serves as Manager of the Nanotechnology Research Center, the Advanced Manufacturing Initiative, and the Emerging Technologies program. Dr. Geraci has practiced multiple aspects of Industrial Hygiene for over 42 years in both the public and private sectors, including two tours at NIOSH and serving as Associate Director for HS&E at the Procter & Gamble Company. Dr. Geraci earned a B.S. in chemistry from the University of Cincinnati and a Ph.D. in chemistry from the Michigan State University. He is an American Board of Industrial Hygiene Certified Industrial Hygienist, and is a Fellow of the American Industrial Hygiene Association. Dr. Geraci has earned national and international recognition for his scientific leadership in the field and for his ability to translate complex scientific issues into practical guidance for worker protection, and in 2017 was designated a NIOSH Distinguished Career Scientist. He serves as a subject matter expert on various national and international panels and advisory boards, including representing NIOSH on the U.S. National Nanotechnology Initiative and the White House OSTP Sub-Committee on Advanced Manufacturing.
