Research Priorities for Airborne Particulate Matter

- Congress directed EPA to arrange for an NRC study on research priorities for PM research program (4 reports, 1998-2004).
- Identified high-priority research topics linked to key policy-related scientific uncertainties. Resulted in an integrated research roadmap with short- and long-term timing and estimated costs for the research.

Impacts

- Provided objective, independent assessment
- Fostered long-term planning and intra-agency integration
- Encouraged sustained Congressional funding for PM research.

EHS Research Efforts

- NNI asked National Research Council to review Federal Strategy for Environmental, Health, and Safety (EHS) Research Needs for Engineered Nanoscale Materials
- Senate/Congressional support for development of research roadmap for Federal government, including monitoring how research is being carried out over time.
